## Here at Magee MS, we offer three levels of Band: Beginning, Intermediate, and Advanced.

Beginning Band is designed for those students who have had up to a year of experience on a band instrument.

Intermediate Band is designed for those students who have had between 2 and 3 years of experience on a band instrument.

Advanced Band is designed for those students who have had 3+ years of experience on a band instrument. Students have the option to audition into either of Intermediate Band or Advanced Band with the teacher approval.

- Instrument Magee MS Bands offer: Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone, Bari Saxophone, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone, Tuba, and Percussion - all Beginning Band students start on Bell Kit.

Performance Concerts: Students enrolled in band will have between 3 and 4 concerts per year both at Magee MS and surrounding east side high schools. Students have the opportunity as $7^{\text {th }}$ graders and $8^{\text {th }}$ graders to audition into the TUSD Honor Band that happens in the spring. Students in Advanced Band will have the chance to travel to the TUSD Advanced Band Festival in the spring where they will perform, and receive feedback from a clinician, as well as perform a few times in the spring for the TUSD Level Up
 Days for incoming $6^{\text {th }}$ graders.
